- Quick reference to all crisis, health, housing, education and reintegration programs.
- A pre-vetted Library with written content and interactive assessment, educational and recovery programs.
- A legislative information and advocacy tool.
- All local, state and national support groups and programs.
- An HL7-registered Personal Health Record to store valuable medical information as well as content from throughout the Network of Care site.
- All assistive devices made in North America, searchable by function.
- News from around the country.
- Best-practice content-sharing from throughout the U.S.
- Human-translated, culturally appropriate translations for key conditions.
